How to Change Default Printer Settings on MAC (10.11) (Black and white default)

Do the following after driver install

- 1. In Safari go to http://localhost:631
- 2. Go to "Printers"
- 3. Click on the printer that you want to change
- 4. On the Administrator Dropdown choose "Set Default Options"
- 5. Click "Color"
- 6. Go to "Color Mode" and change the dropdown from "Automatic" to "Black and White"
 - a. If there are two "Color Modes" change both to "Black and white"
- 7. Click "Set Default Options" (located at the bottom of the screen)
- 8. Enter in an Administrator Username and Password

Set Printer to always default (Default on mac in Last used print settings)

- 1. Open a program that can print (Word, Safari, Text Edit, etc)
- 2. File -> Print or $(\mathcal{H}+P)$
- 3. Under the Presets Dropdown click "Show Presets"*
- 4. At the bottom of the menu you will see a checkable option "Reset preset to menu to "default setting" after printing" that needs to be checked

^{*}If you cannot see the "show preset" option, click the "show details" button at the bottom of the print menu
